

Marsworth C of E Infant School Sports Funding received for the academic year 2019-2020 - £15000

No Events after March 2020 due to COVID-19

Marsworth School uses part of this funding for membership to the Dacorum School Sport Partnership and pays for the associated travel costs. It gives our KS1 children the chance to experience a variety of different sports during competition afternoons. They also take part in a Small Schools Festival. PE training for staff is also offered as part of this partnership.

Unusually, for a small infant school, we run a very successful swimming programme in which all our Nursery and Reception, Year one and Year two children are taken to Aquavale for swimming lessons. The sports funding supports the extra staffing costs required in providing this programme. Training costs have also been paid for via the funding.

Our children have a PE lesson every week, held in the Autumn and Spring terms in our local village hall. The funding will contribute towards the costs for this. A small amount of money has been spent on new resources and we are planning to upgrade our sports storage facilities in the future along with the improving the provision of resources and activities for the playground.
